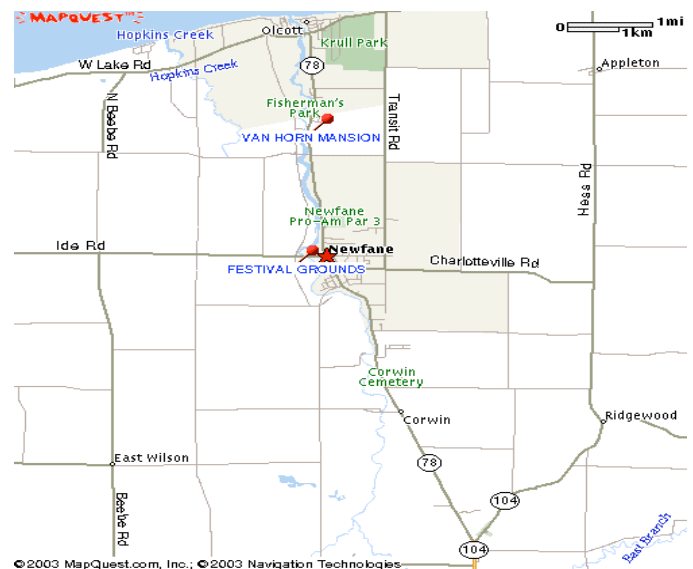
**ANTIQUE VEHICLES** – Antique car and truck owners are invited to display their vehicles in a specially provided area.
